Notable climbers represented here include J. Logan Aikman, Sir Hugh Munro, and Rev A.E. Robertson. The minute book of the Junior Mountaineering Club of Scotland, Glasgow Section, 1925-1936, together with a letter and menu cards for dinners of the JMCS, 1930-1948, have also been deposited.

Much of the material listed here was deposited in the Library in 1971 and 1972 as Dep.179 and Dep.198; additional material was deposited in 1995 and 1996. This inventory supersedes all previous lists. See also Acc.11851.
