

SUPPLEMENT TO NEW ROUTES PUBLISHED IN SMCJ 2010

The following routes were late additions to the print version and are included here to maintain the digital record.

NORTHERN HIGHLANDS NORTH

ASSYNT, Loch Glendhu, Thrust Crag:

On the north side of Loch Glendhu, about 3 miles from the A834 at Kylesku, an unnamed line of quartzite cliffs slants down from west to east just above the loch. Towards the right-hand end, at NC 274 341, a dark bay is apparent, with a prominent corner line to the right of an overhung wall. At the base of the bay is a surprisingly large flat area, not well seen from below.

Holly Tree Corner 36m Very Difficult. Geoff Cohen, Des Rubens, Noel Williams. 19 Apr 2009.

1. 18m The corner rises in two steps, the second a little steeper, to a capacious stony ledge.
2. 18m Move right, climb a black wall behind the holly tree, and finish up the corner line.

Jade Goody Memorial Chimney 36m VS 4c. Geoff Cohen, Des Rubens. 19 Apr 2009.

On the left of the bay a dark slit chimney is topped by a steep left-facing corner. A loose climb that has its moments of exposure.

1. 18m Climb up to a steep section with a chockstone that is passed to gain good protection in a wide crack. Finish by back and foot or bridging.
2. 18m Climb the continuation corner then move right to gain easier, more vegetated rock to finish.
